

## **Mask Update 3/18/2022**

Infinity Gymnastics Academy will be updating our masking policy as of Friday, March 18, 2022. Masks will no longer be required for entry into building as well as athletes to participate in classes, and team practices. We feel comfortable making this change, but encourage families to be vigilant. Michigan has entered into a recovery phase and according to the CDC, Livingston County and surrounding counties have Low community levels at this time.

We still have a few requirements for parents/ adults. All parents/adults participating in PARENT TOT classes are **REQUIRED** to wear a mask during class. Masks will no longer be required in the lobby areas though we still recommend them.

We recommend your child still wear a mask to practice if:

- They are not vaccinated
- if unvaccinated - Gymnasts need to wear a mask 5 days after coming back from vacation/Trip
- Been exposed regardless of vaccination status

Please remember, if you or your child are feeling sick, stay home. You may choose to have your gymnast wear a mask at any time. Please also be aware, that our mask policy will be under review if current health statuses for our area change.

We understand there are a lot of feelings and personal beliefs in play. We are setting these policies as a business trying our best to keep everybody safe and, ask you to help us by following these policies.

Infinity gymnastics is in no way advising or directing people to get their children vaccinated. We understand that is a private matter and for a family to decide. As a business, we are doing our best to follow the Michigan State and CDC guidelines.
